Please sell as many as you can (ask at the school office if you would like more!) and return the stubs with the cash to the school office by Wednesday 17th June. *Note only Name and Phone number need to be completed on the stubs!*

If you would prefer to pay by card, please come to the school office on Thursday or Friday mornings between half term and the fair, with the completed stubs so your order can be processed. **Please return any unsold tickets to the office before the fair into the box in the office so they can be reused.**

The raffle tickets will also be on sale at the fair. The draw will take place at about 2pm at the Summer Fair.

Non-Uniform Day and Donations

Friday 12th June is a non-uniform day so your child can wear their own clothes to school. In return, we are asking for each child to bring in 3-5 items to donate for the tombola. These do not need to be bought especially for this and hopefully can be found around the house.

Examples include:

- Unopened toiletries you were gifted but have never used
- Unopened food items e.g. chocolates/biscuits/teabags/tins – or anything you can find in the cupboard (not anything with a short expiry date please)
- Drinks – unopened soft drinks and squash
- Bottles of alcohol
- Stationary or craft sets that are unopened
- Any other items which you think others would like to win, but you no longer need

We would also be grateful for other donations in the lead up to the fair- so keep an eye out for these over half term:

- **Teddies/soft toys**– *if you have some teddies/soft toys (no battery-operated ones) which need a new home, please leave in the boxes outside the school office from 8th-12th June*
- **Party bag gifts/small plastic gifts** – *if you have some unused/nearly new small plastic toys we would love these for the fair. For example, stickers/mini bubbles/stretchy toys/squishy toys/small popper toys/bouncy balls. Please leave in the boxes outside the school office from 8th-12th June.*

Home baked cakes

For any keen bakers we would love donations of freshly baked cakes, cookies, brownies, flapjacks etc appealing to children and adults.
