If your concerns relate to the actions or behaviour of a member of staff (which could suggest that s/he is unsuitable to work with children) then you should report this to the DSL (Head Teacher only) in confidence. If the concern relates to the Head Teacher, this must be reported to Claire Bryant (Safeguarding Governor – contact details available through the school office).
